Tasting Notes

“Aromas of fresh, fully ripe black-flesh plums and black cherries dominate the nose, enhanced by notes of vanilla and baking spices, red apple, and sandalwood. As the wine warms and breathes, the overall aroma impression becomes more complex, with background notes of sweet sage and barrel toast adding depth to the fruit impression. At entry, the fully ripe fruit takes center stage, displaying smooth, syrupy, juicy flavors and a soft, broad texture. The mouthfeel stays consistently full and smooth throughout the lingering finish, and slowly closes with a focused impression of black berry fruit.”
