Tasting Notes

Aromas are of big, forward, bright fresh fruit; blackberry, boysenberry, and cassis. Notes of vanilla, allspice, cinnamon stick, and a touch of cedar add complexity to the aromas. On the front of the palate, the impression is very full, soft, and ripe, with lots of juicy berry and vanilla flavors. The texture is dense, soft, and fruit-focused through the finish, with sweet boysenberry/blackberry flavors lingering. The wine is amazing.
