Tasting Notes

This bright, fresh 2012 Sauvignon Blanc neatly walks the line both aromatically and flavor-wise between a fruit-forward wine and an intriguing, complex wine with subtle earth, mineral and floral tones. It has aromas of fresh white peaches, honeydew melon, and ripe pineapple. Bright lemon zest intertwines with wet stone and jasmine flavors in a fresh, crisp, bone-dry rendition of this classic grape. The wine was aged primarily in neutral French oak and stainless steel barrels. It was kept on the lees for several months to add mid-palate texture and body. The faintest hint of new French oak adds a base note of complexity to the ripe, fruit-driven finish.
